The **Two Mountain** vineyard is on 26 acres located in the Rattlesnake Hills AVA and produces 8 varietals. With only 3000 cases produced annually, **Two Mountain** is a small winery that concentrates on detail in the vineyard and in the winemaking. We currently produce **Chardonnay, Riesling, Dry Rosé, Lemberger, Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet Franc**, and two red blends.
